RESOLUTION R-05-2025

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR COMMONWEALTH EDISON COMPANY

Be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Northlake, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of Northlake's home rule powers as follows:

SECTION 1: The Grant of Easement for Commonwealth Edison Company in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved subject to such amendments as authorized by the Mayor. The Mayor is authorized to sign the Grant of Easement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this resolution.



AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NO. 6 BY THE CITY OF NORTHLAKE FOR THE CONDOMINIUM BUILDING LOCATED AT 22 KING ARTHUR COURT, AND PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND OTHER PROCEDURES IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Northlake, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Authority to Establish Special Service Areas. That the City of Northlake ("Northlake") has authority pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 to provide special services to contiguous areas within its corporate limits and within the corporate limits of other consenting municipalities; and to provide the manner of levying and imposing additional taxes to pay the cost of such special service in accordance with the provisions of the Special Service Area Tax Law, 36 ILCS 200/27-6, et seq.

- Section 3: Public Hearing Tax Rates Bonds. That a public hearing shall be held at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 21, 2025, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 55 E. North Avenue, Northlake, Illinois, to consider the creation of Special Service Area No. 6, in the following described territory:

ORDINANCE NO. O-03-2025

AN ORDINANCE OPTING LEYDEN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT 212 OUT OF THE COOK COUNTY PAID LEAVE ORDINANCE (SECTION 42-1 THROUGH 42-10 OF THE COOK COUNTY CODE)

WHEREAS, the City of Northlake, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and may, pursuant to said authority, undertake any action and adopt any ordinance relating to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2023, Public Act 102-1143, the Illinois Paid Leave for All Workers Act (820 ILCS 192/1 et seq.) ("Act") became law; and

WHEREAS, the Act establishes a mandatory paid leave standard for all employees in Illinois with exemptions for park district and school district employees; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 6(i) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that home rule units of local government may exercise and perform concurrently with the State any power or function to the extent that the General Assembly by law does not specifically limit the concurrent exercise or specifically declare the State's exercise to be exclusive; and

WHEREAS, the Act does not preempt the City's home rule authority; and

WHEREAS, the Cook County Board of Commissioners ("County") adopted the Cook County Paid Leave Ordinance ("County Ordinance"), effective December 31, 2023, which, like the Act, requires employers in the County to provide certain minimum paid leave benefits to certain employees, but without exception for park district and school district employees; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners on March 14, 2024, adopted an amendment to the County Ordinance to temporarily exempt school districts and park districts from complying with the County Ordinance until January 1, 2025 ("Temporary County Exemption"); and

WHEREAS, despite the State having exempted park districts and school districts from the Act, the County has not extended the Temporary County Exemption, which means park districts and school districts located in the County must comply with the County Ordinance beginning on January 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2023, the City adopted Ordinance 0-28-2023, opting the City as an employer out of the County Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Leyden Community Unit School District 212, an Illinois public school district located in Cook County ("the School District"), operates its West Leyden High School within the City's corporate limits and has requested that the City opt-out from the County Ordinance the School District's employees who are primarily engaged in work within the City; and

WHEREAS, the School District has requested the City to adopt this ordinance in order allow the School District to opt out of the County Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Northlake, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of the City's home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into, and made a part of, this Ordinance as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. EXEMPTION FROM COUNTY ORDINANCE.

- A. Pursuant to its authority as a home-rule municipality, the City hereby declares that the School District is exempt from following the County Ordinance for its own employees who are primarily engaged in work within the City and may continue to offer those employees the same paid leave benefits that they currently provide to those employees, as such benefits may be amended from time to time.
- B. This ordinance governs over and supersedes all provisions of the County Ordinance to the extent of conflict between the two ordinances.
- C. This ordinance, once adopted, applies to all employees of the School District who are primarily engaged in work within the City.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
