REQUIRED INFORMATION:

- A copy of the Plat of survey showing proposed structure and distance of structure from lot lines and other buildings.
- A copy of construction plans (specification sheet, if constructed from a kit) showing material to be used
- Size of Proposed Structure _____ (**MUST** be 50 Square feet or less)
- Structure shall be no closer than ten (10') feet from all property lines and at least twenty (20') feet from any neighboring dwelling.
- The coop and run shall be located in the rear of the residential structure. Not the side or front yards.
- Proof of Registration with the Illinois Department of Agriculture Livestock Premises
- Proof/certificate from a chicken caring course.
- Permit Fee (\$25)

GENERAL INFORMATION: (please initial all)

1. _____ I grant the City the right to enter my property, upon reasonable notice, to inspect the coop as necessary for compliance with City regulations.
2. _____ And provide proof that the applicant has passed a course covering the fundamentals of the compassionate care of chickens, such as that provided by [The Open Sanctuary Project](#).
3. _____ Existing chicken keepers shall have four months from the enactment of this ordinance to apply for a permit, during which time they shall not be penalized for any nonconformance from its requirements, but shall bring their chicken housing up to the standards as delineated herein.
