	 I grant the City the right to enter my property, upon reasonable notice, to inspect the coop as necessary for compliance with City regulations. And provide proof that the applicant has passed a course covering the fundamentals of the compassionate care of chickens, such as that provided by The Open Sanctuary Project. Existing chicken keepers shall have four months from the enactment of this ordinance to apply for a permit, during which time they shall not be penalized for any nonconformance from its requirements, but shall bring their chicken housing up to the standards as delineated herein.
